Implementation Guide

- June 2015 - Federal government published the steps and actions for the publication of Open Data in datos.gob.mx
- 2017 - The Implementation Guide was **renewed** with the collaboration of the citizens, users and Open Data experts in society and government
 - The renewed version maintains the 4 stages of implementations embodied in 2015:

1. Planning

2. Publishing

3. Perfectionating

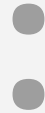
Open Contracting

- Implemented by international experts in transparency, anticorruption, open contracting and open data
- Mapping, standardization and publication of open data to prevent, detect, investigate and sanction corruption acts
- Exploration and capacity building
- Case studies and recommendations to leverage open data at the federal level and the National Anti-corruption System

Case 6 - On going | Implementation of the Open Up Guide for Anti corruption

Phase 1 August, 2017

- **Mapping exercise to fill out inventory of anticorruption data**
 - Working groups with more than 40 public servants that produce and consume potential useful data to fight corruption
- Identification of more than 65 useful data sets in Mexico to fight corruption
- Creation of a method to rank level of openness for datasets

Phase 2 November, 2017

- **Generate and test** the technical and analytical capacities for data processing and generations of actions by public servants, civil society, journalists and private sector
- Identification of cases and trends of uses to fight corruption in Mexico

Phase 3 Mar - Jun 2018

- **Case studies and recommendations** to leverage open data at the federal level and the National Anti-corruption System

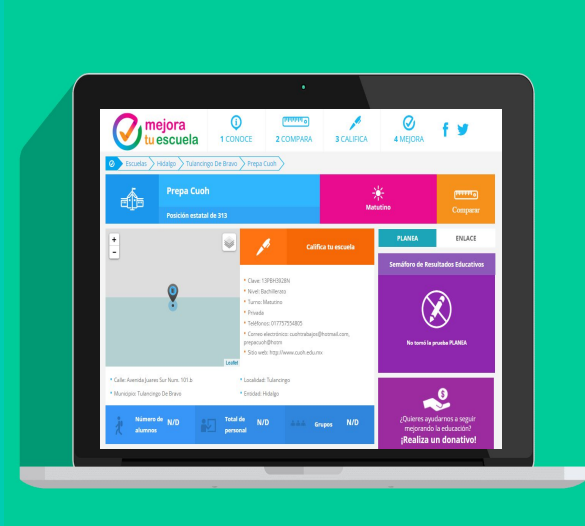
