CP/RES. 646 (1022/95)

GRANTING THE CZECH REPUBLIC THE STATUS  
OF PERMANENT OBSERVER TO THE ORGANIZATION

THE PERMANENT COUNCIL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES,

HAVING SEEN the request from the Government of the Czech Republic to be granted the status of permanent observer to the Organization of American States (CP/doc.2550/95), and the Report by the Chairman of the Committee on Juridical and Political Affairs on granting the Czech Republic the status of Permanent Observer to the Organization (CP/doc.2558/95); and

CONSIDERING:

That through resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-O/71) the General Assembly established the status of Permanent Observer to the Organization of American States and entrusted the Permanent Council with the task of determining the criteria and timeliness to give effect to that provision; and

That under resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84) any independent state may request the status of Permanent Observer to the OAS, in accordance with resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-O/71),

RESOLVES:

1. To grant the Czech Republic the status of Permanent Observer to the Organization of American States, under the terms of General Assembly resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-O/71) and this Council's resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84).

2. To invite the Government of the Czech Republic to accredit a permanent observer to the organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization, as established in operative paragraph 7 of resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84).

3. To ask the Secretary General to communicate the foregoing to the organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization, including the inter-American specialized organizations, once the Government of the Czech Republic has been apprised of this decision.
