CP/RES. 640 (1011/94)

GRANTING THE REPUBLIC OF LEBANON THE STATUS
OF PERMANENT OBSERVER TO THE ORGANIZATION

THE PERMANENT COUNCIL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES,

HAVING SEEN the request from the Government of Lebanon that the Republic of Lebanon be granted the status of permanent observer to the Organization of American States and the report of the Committee on Juridical and Political Affairs on granting that state the status of permanent observer to the Organization (CP/doc.2536/94); and

CONSIDERING:

That through resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-O/71) the General Assembly established the status of permanent observers to the Organization of American States and entrusted the Permanent Council with the task of determining the criteria time frame for implementation of that provision; and

That under resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84) any independent state may request the status of permanent observer to the OAS, in accordance with resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-O/71),

RESOLVES:

1. To grant the Republic of Lebanon the status of permanent observer to the Organization of American States, under the terms of General Assembly resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-O/71) and this Council's resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84).
2. To invite the Government of Lebanon to accredit a permanent observer to the organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization, as established in operative paragraph 7 of resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84).
3. To ask the Secretary General to report this decision to the organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization, including the inter-American specialized organizations, once the Government of Lebanon has been apprised thereof.
